Rules of the Competition

- 1) The competition is open to all amateur photographers residing in the Horsham District
- 2) The entry form is also available on the society's web site: www.horshamphotographicsociety.co.uk
- 3) Prints shall represent the photographer's view of Wonderful Sussex (East or West). Location must be given on the Entry Form.
- 4) Entries will be in 2 classes: Class 1 for those under 18 years old on 16th July 2019 and Class 2 for those 18 years or older on 16th July 2019.
- 5) Entries shall be labelled clearly on the back with the print title and location, entrant's name, address, telephone number and the class number. For entries in class 1, the date of birth must be included. Please do not write directly onto the prints, use labels.
- 6) Prints must be a minimum of 5X7 inches in size to a maximum of A4 and submitted unmounted in a sealed envelope along with the entry form.
- 7) There are no limits as to the number of prints submitted. Prints cannot be returned.
- 8) The entry fee will be £1 per print - Class 1 and £2 per print – Class 2. Cheques shall be made payable to Horsham Photographic Society. If including cash, please enclose in a separate envelope with the entry form and prints.
- 9) Prints may be colour or monochrome and may be printed commercially.
- 10) Prizes will be awarded in each class: £50 first, £30 second and £15 third place. Three highly commended images will also be announced in each class. The results will be published on the club website. Winners will be asked to send an electronic copy for publication on the website and to be sent to the local press. The judges' decisions will be final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 11) Winning and highly commended entries will be returned framed and mounted.
- 12) HPS reserves the right to reproduce any entry on its website without fee, and also make them available at exhibitions and to the local press. But subject to this, the copyright shall remain with the author at all times.
- 13) Submission of an entry indicates acceptance of these rules.

Members of Horsham Photographic Society and their immediate family are excluded from entry
